The school observed Vana Mahotsav Week from 1st July to 7th July 2025 with the objective of promoting environmental awareness and encouraging sustainable practices among students.

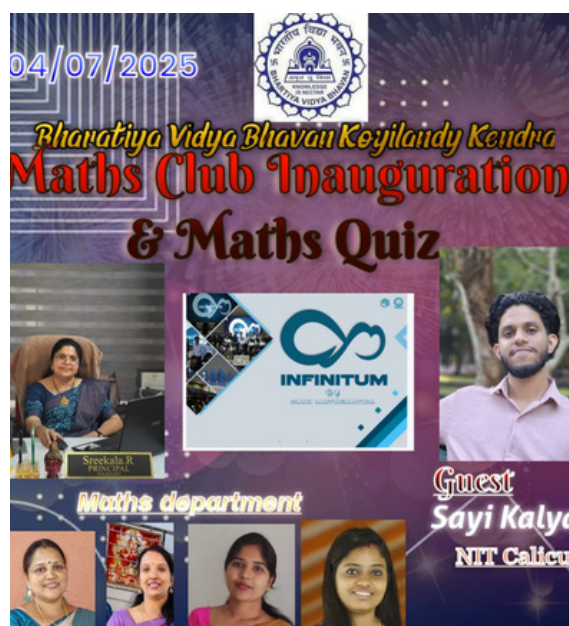

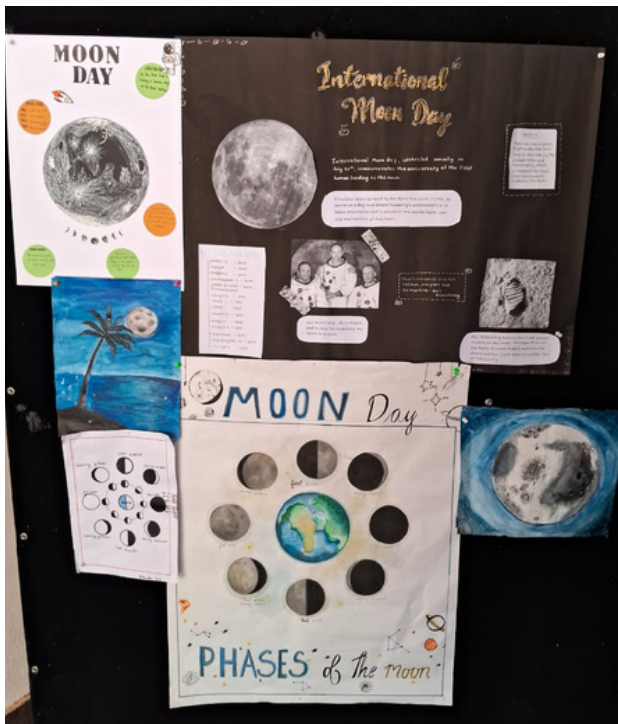


RAMAYANA MONTH CELEBRATION
