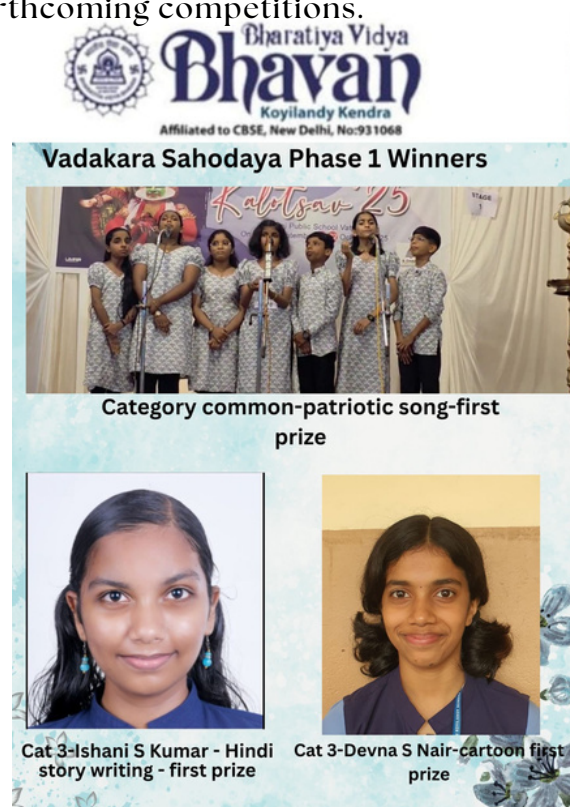


ROOTS AND WINGS: EMBRACING THE JOURNEY
